Individual Player Financial Obligation

It is the responsibility of the High School Soccer to self-fund most costs. This burden falls entirely to the boosters club and the individual players/guardians. For the Boys' Soccer Program to be successful, ALL parent/guardians need to support the team by volunteering in whatever ways possible. In addition to volunteering, each player will have a financial obligation. Put simply, the more funds raised by the boosters, the lower the required individual financial obligation. Each season an individual player obligation is calculated. This amount is calculated by estimating total seasonal costs to be born by the boys' program, subtracting total revenue from funds raised through fund-raising activities, and then dividing that figure by the number of players on the team. The exact figure is to be calculated sometime before the season's first road game. Assuming some basic funds are raised, it is estimated that the 2009 player obligation will be approximately \$525.00 for Varsity Players and \$65.00 for Junior Varsity Players. If fund raising is surprisingly robust, these amounts could be reduced. The individual player obligation may be met by obtaining team sponsors, by receiving donations in a player's name, or by out-of-pocket payments. This amount does not include potential post-season play. If the team does well and advances to the State Championships, the funds needed must be fund-raised, or additional player obligations (*circa* \$175.00) may exist. Please begin to solicit team sponsors and donations to the general fund NOW, as any sponsorships or donations received prior to April 15 will serve to reduce the players' 2009 individual obligation (sponsorship forms and donation information is downloadable from main wolfpacksoccer.org page). Also any specialized team outerwear to be purchased will be the responsibility of the individual player. On or about April 15, a per player obligation will be calculated. If by that time the player has obtained any of the following, he will not have to pay the financial obligation, if not, his guardian will be required to either donate or pay the required amount. All players (JV and V) will need to register with FYSA and pay them \$35 (today). Each player will also be asked to contribute \$15 (today) as a concessions start-up fee to be used to purchase items for team sales at home games. A Uniform Deposit will also be collected (not cashed).

Ways to meet the individual player obligation:

Varsity Player*—can meet obligation as follows:	JV Player**—can meet obligation as follows:
• Two or more \$250.00 Business Sponsorships	• One or more \$250.00 Business Sponsorships
• \$525 or more in Donations in Player's Name	• \$65 or more in Donations in Player's Name
• Out of Pocket Payment by Parent/Guardian	• Out of Pocket Payment by Parent/Guardian

* If a Varsity player does not travel, it is possible he might have an obligation that is reduced by approximately \$350.

** If a JV player is moved up and taken on a trip outside Fairbanks, his obligation will increase by approximately \$400 (so if coach has suggested this is a possibility you should probably obtain two sponsors or +\$500 in donations)
